The return shall be kept by this Council for a period of at least 18 months and any member of the public will be permitted to inspect it during office hours free of charge.

Any person who fails to send a return in accordance the above act, or who knowingly gives in any such return sent by him any information which is false, or who certifies any such return knowing it to contain such information, shall be guilty of an offence.
